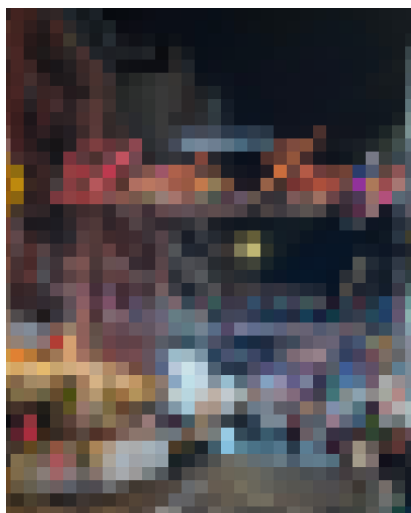

The tour ends in Little Italy where you can enjoy the neighborhood, including fine Italian food and drink.

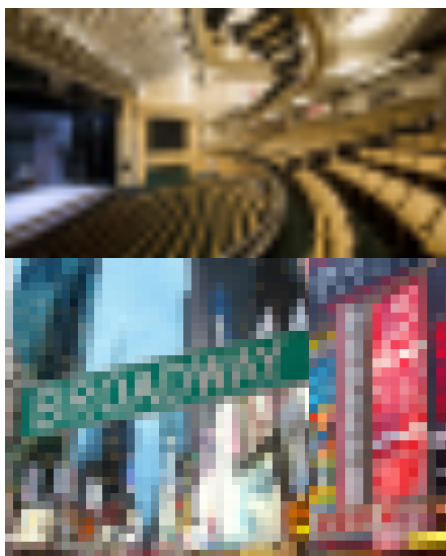

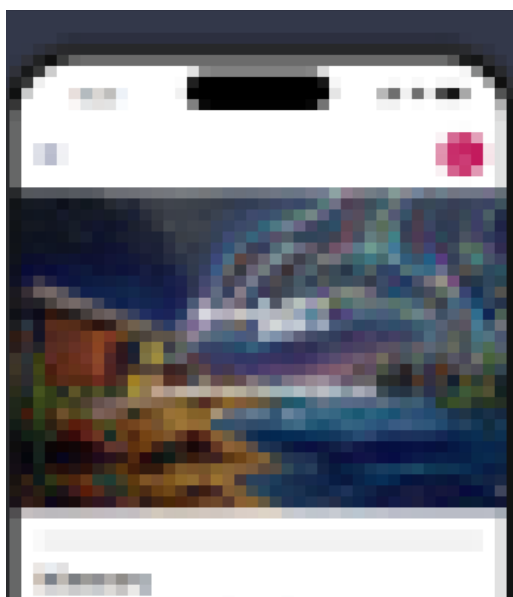

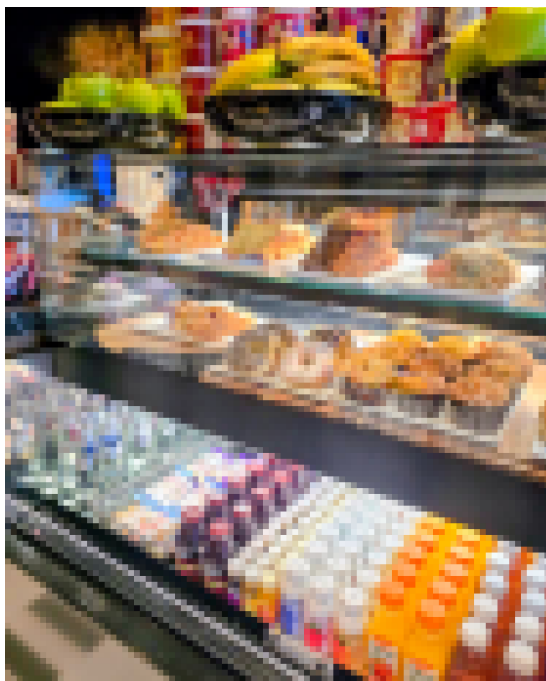
